Delaware CAMP

CAMP, from the National Association of Preservation Commissions, will be held on Saturday, April 4th, from 9:00 AM to 4 PM at the University of Delaware’s Viriden Center located at 700 Pilottown Road in Lewes. Check in at 8:30 AM. Since its inception in 2001, CAMP has trained more than 3,000 local commission members, staff, elected officials, and others from throughout the United States.

Who Should Attend

Historic Preservation Commission members, planning committees or boards, representatives from cities and towns considering adopting a preservation ordinance, and other persons interested in historic preservation are encouraged to attend. Attendees will receive a resource manual compiled by NAPC with the most comprehensive, concise, and up-to-date material available. The course is led by nationally recognized experts from NAPC.
